



2024 Contributions and Charges

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The South Thornlie Primary School Board has endorsed our schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024 in accordance with the School Education Regulations 2000 as part of the School Education Act 1999. This schedule is designed to provide you with information about anticipated costs that may occur throughout the coming school year and allow you time for forward planning of the likely outlays.

This schedule is made up of the following areas:

1. Voluntary Contributions: Contributions are voluntary, and they have been set at **\$60.00 per student**. This equates to approximately \$1.50 per week. This represents an important revenue source and supplements school expenditure in the areas listed over the page.

While contributions are voluntary, the quality of our learning programs will be maximised when all families contribute. Payments can be made directly to the school (after receiving the first statement of the year) or via Campion booklist.

Campion's Booklist (www.campion.com.au) enables parents to pay for School Contributions and Student School Lists during ordering. The cut off day for ordering through the school is Friday, 1 December 2023. Online orders are available until 19 January 2024.

***Should you experience any difficulty in paying your child's voluntary contributions and charges, we can assist you with setting up an instalment schedule for paying the contributions and charges over the course of the school year.**

2. Personal Item's List: All students from Kindy to Year 6 will have a Campion Booklist for their year level. Parents may purchase these items from their chosen retailer or Campion (25b Baile Road, Canning Vale 6155).

3. Charges: Curriculum Related Activities and Extra Cost Items: Students will engage in a variety of activities associated with educational programs for which charges will be incurred. This amount can vary from year level to year level. The Schedule of Charges section is outlined over the page.

4. P&C Contribution: This year the P&C are requesting a voluntary payment from families. This assists in providing much needed amenities for the school. The amounts are \$20/student or \$40/family. Funds are going towards improving school grounds and facilities. P&C payments can be made directly to the school.
