



# CONSENT FORM

## Media/Internet/Viewing

At South Thornlie Primary School we aim to offer your child the widest range of learning opportunities, celebrate learning whenever possible and promote our school. This may often require some form of parental consent. This form asks you to consent (or otherwise) to your child's participation / use / access to several aspects of the school program. At all times we make the very best efforts to exercise exemplary standards in respect of duty of care.

### MEDIA CONSENT

Photographic images of your child taken during school activities are used for the purpose of educating students, promoting the school or promoting public education. The school is seeking permission to publish images of your child and/or samples of your child's work. If you give permission, the school may publish images of your child and/or samples of your child's work in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, newspapers, on the internet, in newsletters, STPS web page [www.souththornlieps.wa.edu.au](http://www.souththornlieps.wa.edu.au), on film, television or video. Your child's name may be included but no contact details are provided. Work/images captured by the school will be kept for no longer than is necessary for the purposes outlined above and will be stored and disposed of securely.

### INTERNET ACCESS

Student access to the internet is provided in accordance with the Information Communication Technology (ICT) Acceptable Use Agreement, K-2 or 3-6. Student access is contingent on abiding by the Student Guidelines for Acceptable Use of ICT. Before completing this section we request that parents of students Years K-2 read the ICT Acceptable Use Agreement included in this enrolment pack. Parents of students in Years 3-6 need to read and discuss the ICT Acceptable Use Agreement with their child and both the parent and their child need to sign the form in addition to responding below.

- Yes, my child has permission to access the internet in accordance with ICT Acceptable Use Agreement.

### VIEWING CONSENT

Children often watch videos / DVDs / television documentaries as part of their learning. Almost always, these are 'G' rated and don't require consent. Very occasionally something with a 'PG' rating is appropriate for which we would need parental permission.

- Yes, I consent to my child viewing items with a 'PG' rating if deemed suitable by the teacher and school administration.  
 No, I do not give consent.

### SEESAW

Seesaw is an optional communication tool that some teachers may choose to use. I understand that consent to Seesaw means that both parents will have access to communication with your child's classroom teacher and be able to view your child's work samples, unless court orders are in place.

- Yes, I consent to the use of Seesaw as a tool for communication with my child's teacher.  
 No, I do not give consent.

### CONNECT

Connect is a platform for communication and the provision of information. Copies of notes to parents will be published as 'notifications', and this is where you will go to keep up to date with current events at school.

- Yes, I consent to the use of Connect for parent/caregiver 1 and 2 to access school information in relation to my child.
